



EVERGREEN MITTENS

DIFFICULTY =

YARN = 2 balls of [VASTO](#) by Laines Du Nord col. Green

HOOK = 4.5 mm

OTHER = tapestry needles, pins, scissors



DIFFICULTY LEVEL: Easy

SAMPLE

POINTS USED

Chain, slip st., single crochet, double crochet, treble crochet .

Double crochet in back loop: yarn over, insert hook only in the back loop of the stitch and work 1 double crochet.

4 treble crochet closed together: * yarn over 2 times and insert hook in the next st, yarn over and extract 1 loop from the st., (yarn over and pull it through 2 loops on the hook) 2 times *, rep from * to * 3 more times, yarn over and pull it through the 5 sts. on hook

MEASURES

SIZE: S

PROCEDURE

MITTEN

Worked from the bottom up

Work 30 ch and join in the round with 1 sl st in the first ch, ensuring that the work is not twisted.

1 Round: 1 ch (doesn't count as 1a dc), 1 sc in the same st of the ch and in every ch to the end, join with 1 sl st in the 1a sc of the round [30 sc]

2 Round: 6 ch (count as 1a tr and 2 ch), 4 tr closed together in the next 4 sc, 2 ch, (1 tr in the next st., 2 ch, 4 tr closed together in the next 4 sc, 2 ch) 5 times; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning. [6 tr, 6 groups of 4 tr closed together, 12 2ch-spaces]

3 Round: 3 ch (count as 1a dc here and further on), * 2 dc in back loop close together in the next 2 ch., skip 1 group, 1 dc in back loop in each of the next 2 ch, 1 dc in back loop in the next tr, 1 tr in back loop in each of the next 2 ch, skip 1 group, 1 dc in back loop in each of the next 2 ch, 1 dc in back loop in next tr *, rep from * to * 2 more times, omitting the dc in back loop in the last repetition; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [27 sts including 3 ch of the beginning]

4 - 7 Rounds: 3 ch, 1 dc in every st of the round; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [27 dc]

Now, start shaping the mitten on one side to create the thumb.

8 Round: 3 ch and 1 dc in the 1a st (1 increase), 1 dc in the next 25 sts, 2 dc in the last st (2 increase); 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [29 sts.]

9 Round: 3 ch, 2 dc in the next st (1 increase), 1 dc in the next 25 sts, 2 dc in the next st (2 increase), 1 dc in the last st; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [31 sts]

10 Round: 3 ch, 1 dc in the next st, 2 dc in the next st (1 increase), 1 dc in the next 25 sts, 2 dc in the next st (2 increase), 1 dc in the last 2 sts; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [33 sts]

11 Round: 3 ch, 1 dc in the next 2 sts, 2 dc in the next st (1 increase), 1 dc in the next 25



sts, 2 dc in the next st (2 increase), 1 dc in the last 3 sts; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [35 sts]

Make the space for the thumb as follows:

12 Round: 1 sl st in each of the next 4 sts, 3ch and 1 dc (1 increase) in the 2a st of the 1 increase of previous round, 1 dc in the next 25 sts, 2 dc in the 1a st of the increase of the previous round (2 increase), 1 ch, skip the next 8 sts (thumb-space) and close with 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [29 sts, 1 1ch- space]

Now, continue only on the sts. of the upper part of the mitten, temporarily leaving aside the sts. for the thumb.

13 Round: 3 ch, 1 dc in the next 28 sts, 1 dc in the next. ch; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [30 sts]

14 - 17 Rounds: 3 ch, 1 dc in the next 29 sts.; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [30 sts]

Once you have reached about 20 cm from the rib edge, before decreasing to shape the tip, try on the mitten and if necessary work 1 or 2 more rounds as above.

Next Round: 3 ch, 2 dc closed together in the next 2 sts, (1 dc in the next st, 2 dc closed together in the next 2 sts) 9 times; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [20 sts]

Next Round: 2 ch and 1 dc closed together in the first 2 sts, (2 dc closed together in the next 2 sts) 9 times; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [10 sts]

Last Round: 1 ch and 1 sc closed together in the first 2 sts, (2 sc closed together in the next 2 sts) 4 times; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [5 sts]

Cut the yarn and close, leaving a long tail.

Insert the tapestry needle with the bind-off thread and pass it through the sts. of the last round, pull the thread to tighten the sts. and close the central hole, then hide between the sts. the remaining thread.

Thumb

1 Round: on RS, join the yarn with 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning of 12 round (central st of the 8 dc not worked of the thumb-space), 3 ch, 1 dc in each of the next 2 dc not worked of 11 round, 2 dc in the next dc not worked, (3 groups of 2 dc closed together) in the last ch of the 12 round (back side of the thumb), 1 dc in the last 4 sts not worked of the 11 round; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [12 sts]



2 Round: 3 ch, 1 dc in every st of the round; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning

[12 sts]

3 Round: 3 ch, 2 dc closed together in the next 2 sts, (1 dc in the next st, 2 dc closed together in the next 2 sts) 3 times; 1 sl st in the 3a ch from the beginning [8 sts]

Try on the mitten and, if necessary, work one more round before the last round.

Last Round: 1 ch and 1 sc close together in the first 2 sts, (2 sc closed together) 3 times; 1 sl st on top of the 1 group of round.

Cut the yarn and fasten, leaving a long tail to tighten and close the sts. as in the last round of the mitten.

Weave in all ends.

Make the 2a mitten as the same way.
