

BON TON SWEATER

DIFFICULTY =

YARN = [Soft Lino](#) by Laines du Nord (50 gr balls) ; 6 balls of color 5

NEEDLES = 3, 3.5, and 4 mm

OTHER = tapestry needle, scissor, pins.



Difficulty level: Intermediate

SAMPLE

POINTS USED

Reverse stocking st., Tubular st., Sewn Bind Off (to cast off with tapestry needle the tubular st.)

1/1 rib st.

1 Row: (K1, P1) to the end

2 Row: work sts as they appear

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for the required length.

2/1 rib st.

1 Row: (K2, P1) to the end

2 Row: work sts as they appear

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for the required length.

Lace st

1 Row: K2 * SKP, 2 YO, K2tog *, rep** to 2 sts before end, K2

2 Row: P to the end (= work the 2 YOs with P1 and P1 through the back loop)

3 Row: like Row 1

4 Row: like Row 2

Rep from Row 1 to Row 5 for the required length.

ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

st(s) = stitch(es)

R = row

K = knit

P = purl

SKP = slip 1, K1, pass slipped stitch over

K2tog = knit 2 sts together

rep** = repeat from * to *

MEASURES

Size M (this pattern is designed to be worn with a positive ease)

PROCEDURE**FRONT**

With needle 3.5 mm, cast on 117 sts and work 16 rows in 2/1 rib st.

Change to needles 4 mm.

Rows 1 - 12: work in reverse stocking st

Row 13 (RS): P1, P2tog (1a decrease), P to 3 sts before end, SKP in purl (2a decrease), P1

Continue in reverse stocking st and on rows 19, 25, 31 e 37, decrease as in Row 13

Rows 38 - 80: work in stocking st on 107 remained sts

Work in lace st., remember to work 1 selvage st. at the beginning of every odd row (RS) and work 2 sts in reverse stocking st on both side of the lace st until the end of the

panel.

Row 81: decrease 8 sts evenly. Work 1 selvage st., P2., work the 1 row in lace st to 2 sts before end, P2 [99 sts]

Rows 82 - 84: rep from row 2 to 4 of the lace st.

Row 85: work in lace st as set up, and cast off the first and the last 4 sts on both side for the armholes.

Continue in lace st and decrease 1 st after the first st and before the last one on rows: 87, 89, 91, 93, 95, 97, 99, 101, 103, 105, 107, 109. At the end of row 109 you have 75 sts on needle.

Row 111: work and cast off the 15 central sts for the neckline.

[30 sts on 1 side, 15 central sts casted-off, 30 sts on 2 side]

Work separately the 2 sides of the neckline

First side

Work in lace st decrease on odd rows (RS) as indicated.

Row 113: cast off 3 sts on neck side and decrease 1 st on the opposite side for the armhole [26 sts]

Row 115: cast off 3 sts on neck side [23 sts.]

Row 117: cast off 3 sts on neck side and decrease 1 st for the armhole [19 sts]

Row 119: cast off 3 sts on neck side. [16 sts]

Row 121: cast off 3 sts on neck side and decrease 1 st for the armhole [12 sts]

Row 123: cast off 4 sts on neck side [8 sts]

Row 125: cast off 4 sts on neck side and decrease 1 st for the armhole [3 sts]

Row 127: cast off the remained 3 sts

Second side

Work as for the 1st side, making the decreases symmetrically.

BACK

Work as for the Front

SLEEVE

With needle 3.5 mm, cast on 54 sts and work 19 rows in 2/1 rib st.

Change to needles 4 mm and Purl 1 row on WS, increasing 20 sts evenly.

Rows 1 - 68 : work in lace st on 74 sts.

Row 69: cast off the 18 central sts and work separately the 2 sides

[28 sts on 1 side, 18 central sts casted-off, 28 sts on 2 side]

First side

Work in lace st decrease on odd rows (RS) as indicated.

Row 71: cast off 3 sts on the casted-off side to create the curved edge of the central opening. [25 sts]

Row 73: cast off 2 sts on central opening side [23 sts]

Row 75: cast off 2 sts on central opening side [21 sts]

Row 77: cast off 1 st on central opening side and 3 sts for the armhole on the opposite side [17 sts]

Row 79: cast off 1 st on central opening side and 1 st for the armhole [15 sts]

Row 81: like row 79 [13 sts]

Row 83: like row 79 [11 sts]

Row 85: cast off 2 sts on central opening side and 1 st for the armhole [8 sts]

Row 87: like Row 85 f. [5 sts]

Row 89: cast off the remained st, inserting 1 st. on the side of the armhole.

Second side

Work as for the First side, making the decreases symmetrically.

Make the second st.

FINISHING

Edges of the central opening of the sleeves (x 2): with needles 3 mm and contrasting yarn, cast on 140 sts and K 1 row. Change to Soft Lino yarn and Purl 1 row, work 4 rows in tubular st then work 8 rows in 1/1 rib st, end with 3 rows in tubular st. Cast off sts with the tapestry needle.

Neckline edge: with the same method as the edges of the central opening, make an edge of 200 sts.

On WS, sew edges around the center opening of each sleeve and around the neckline (photo). Sew the ends of the neckline together at the center back. Sew side and underarm.

Weave in all ends.
