

POEMA PONCHO

DIFFICULTY = Intermediate

YARN = [POEMA](#) by Laines du Nord col n. 100

CIRCULAR NEEDLES = size 4.5 mm tips and 80 cm cable

OTHERS = darning needle, stitch markers, scissors, tape measure.



SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm = 19 stitches and 25 rows in Stockinette stitch using size 4.5 mm tips

It is very important to check your gauge and measure the tension correctly to achieve the same results and measurements as the pattern. If the gauge is different, try adjusting the needle size up or down by half a size until you get the correct measurement.

POINTS USED

ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side of work

WS = wrong side of work

SM = stitch marker

M-SM = move the stitch marker

col = color

st(s) = stitch/es

k = knit

p = purl

yo = yarn over

rep = repeat

rep** = repeat from * to *

bind off = bind off (using the skp technique)

skp = slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped st over (slip 1 st knit-wise, k1, pass slipped st over).

M1L = make 1 left (insert left needle from front to back under the strand between 2 sts and knit 1 st through the back loop).

M1R = make 1 right (insert left needle from back to front under the strand between 2 sts and knit 1 st).

sl1 p-wise = slip 1 stitch purl-wise, holding the yarn at the back of the work.

sl2 p-wise = slip 2 stitches purl-wise, holding the yarn at the back of the work.

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together (insert right needle through the next 2 sts on left needle and knit them together = 1 st).

k3tog = knit 3 stitches together (insert right needle through the next 3 sts on left needle and knit them together = 1 st).

k3tog tbl = knit 3 stitches together through the back loop (work 3 sts together inserting the needle into the back loops)

skp = slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over

MEASURES

SINGLE SIZE = 150 g

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Size shown in the picture: single size

Total length: 160 cm

Folded long side length: 80 cm

Width: 40/45 cm

PROCEDURE

Using size 4.5 mm tips, cast on 92 stitches.

Work 3 rows in 1x1 rib stitch.

Continue working in open-work stitch:

Row 1: sl2 p-wise, *k3, yo, k3tog tbl, yo, *repeat from * to* until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl2 p-wise.

Row 2: purl all sts

Row 3: sl2 p-wise, yo, k3tog tbl, yo, k3, *repeat from * to* until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl2 p-wise.

Row 4: purl all sts

Repeat from Row 1 to Row 4, once.

Continue working in Stockinette stitch:

Row 5: sl2 p-wise, knit until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl2 p-wise.

Row 6: purl all sts

Repeat Row 5 and Row 6, 19 times.

Repeat from Row 1 to Row 4, twice.

Repeat Row 5 and Row 6 until there are 25 grams of yarn.

Continue repeating from Row 1 to Row 4, twice.

Repeat Row 5 and Row 6, 19 times

Repeat from Row 1 to Row 4, twice

At last work 3 rows in 1x1 rib stitch. Length of the rectangle: 160 cm

Finishing:

Fold in half with WS outside (80 cm). Sew 40 cm along the long side, from the 1x1 rib band.

Weave in ends.

KNITTING INSTRUCTIONS

The garment is worked in a single rectangle. The seam is on one side.
