DIFFICULTY = Hard

YARN FOR THE SWEATER = [CASHSILK LIGHT](#) col. 3202 by Laines du Nord (dark blue), 120 grams for size S (M: 125 grams – L: 125 grams – XL: 150 grams) [KID SILK NUANCE](#) col. 023 type H.Couture by Laines du Nord (Dark blue), 120 grams for size S (M: 125 grams – L: 125 grams – XL: 150 grams).

YARN FOR THE SKIRT = [CASHSILK LIGHT](#) col. 3202 by Laines du Nord (Dark blue), 75 grams for size S (M: 90 grams – L: 115 grams – XL: 150 grams), [CASHSILK LIGHT](#) col. 3052 by Laines du Nord (Light blue), 75 grams for size S (M: 90 grams – L: 115 grams – XL: 150 grams), [CASHSILK LIGHT](#) col. 3021 by Laines du Nord (Orange), 50 grams for size S (M: 75 grams – L: 100 grams – XL: 125 grams) [KID SILK NUANCE](#) col. 023 type H.Couture by Laines du Nord (Dark blue), 75 grams for size S (M: 75 grams – L: 90 grams – XL: 90 grams), [KID SILK NUANCE](#) col. 029 type H.Couture by Laines du Nord (Light blue), 50 grams for size S (M: 50 grams – L: 75 grams – XL: 75 grams), [KID SILK NUANCE](#) col. 014 type H.Couture by Laines du Nord (Orange), 50 grams for size S (M: 50 grams – L: 75 grams – XL: 75 grams).

CIRCULAR NEEDLES = size 3.5 – 4 – 4.5 – 6 – 7 mm tips (80 cm and 100 cm cable).

4 CM WIDE ELASTIC BAND = 70 cm in length for size S (M: 75 cm – L: 80 cm – XL: 85 cm)

OTHERS = darning needle, stitch marker, scissors, tape measure.



SAMPLE

SWEATER TENSION



10 x 10 cm = 15 stitches and 24 rows in stockinette stitch using size 4.5 mm tips

SKIRT TENSION

10 x 10 cm = 18 stitches and 32 f rows in stockinette stitch using size 3.5 mm tips

It is very important to check your gauge and measure the tension correctly to achieve the same results and measurements as the pattern.

If the gauge is different, try adjusting the needle size up or down by half a size until you get the correct measurement.

POINTS USED

Join in the round: slip first stitch purl-wise from left to right needle, pass the last stitch over the slipped stitch and drop it, pull the cast-on end tightening the stitch, place one SM (BOR) to mark the beginning and the end of the round; take care to move it at every round.

ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side of the work

WS = wrong side of the work

SM = stitch marker

SM (BOR): stitch marker of the beginning of the round

M-SM = move the SM

col = color

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

rep ** = repeat from * to *

bind off = bind off (using the skp technique)

skp: slip 1 stitch, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over

ssk: slip 2 stitches individually knit-wise, return them on the left needle and knit them together through the back loop; easy decrease to the left.

turn = at the end of every row, turn and slip 1 stitch from left needle to right needle on RS and 1 stitch from right needle to left needle on WS, shaping the cross. Insert the SM1 between two crossed stitches and knit the stitches on the left needle.

cross = for cross shaping, slip 1 stitch from left needle to right needle on RS and one

stitch from right needle to left needle on WS, then return the stitches on left needle.

M1R = using the left needle, lift the strand between 2 stitches from back to front and knit 1.

M1L = using the left needle, lift the strand between 2 stitches from front to back and knit 1 through the back loop.

MEASURES

MEASUREMENTS OF THE SWEATER

Size shown in the picture: S – Other sizes: M - L - XL

Chest circumference: 98 (104 - 110 - 116) cm with 10 cm positive ease.

Total height (front and back): 51 (57 - 63 - 69) cm

Body height from undersleeve: 32 (38 - 44 - 50) cm

Sleeve circumference: 30 (32 - 34 - 36) cm

Sleeve length (from undersleeve to the end of the cuff): 45 (45 - 47 - 47) cm

MEASUREMENTS OF THE SKIRT

Size shown in the picture: S – Other sizes: M - L - XL

Waist circumference: 72 cm (77 - 82 - 93).

Length: 102 cm for all sizes.

PROCEDURE

SWEATER

Using two yarns together, size 4.5 mm tips and 80 cm cable, work the right shoulder and the left shoulder separately.

Right shoulder:

Cast-on 14 (14 - 16 - 16) sts

Set-up Row: p3, SM, p8, SM, p3

Row 1 (RS): k1, M1R, k1, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, k1, M1L, k1.

Row 2 (WS): purl.

Row 3 (RS): k1, M1R, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, k1, M1L, k1.

Repeat Row 2 and row 3, 11 (12 - 13 - 14) more times. There are 92 (98- 106 -112) m

Leave all sts onto a waste yarn

Left shoulder:

Cast-on 14 (14 -16 - 16) sts

Set-up Row: p3, SM, p8, SM, p3 Row 1 (RS): k1, M1R, k1, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, k1, M1L, k1.

Row 2 (WS): purl.

Row 3 (RS): k1, M1R, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, k1, M1L, k1.

Repeat Row 2 and row 3 more 11(12 - 13 - 14) times. There are 92 (98- 106 -112) sts

Leave all sts onto a waste yarn

YOKE:

Move the stitches of both shoulders onto one cable and join the left shoulder and the right shoulder in the round reversing all shaping.

Set-up Round: beginning from right shoulder, move the first 35 (38-42-45) sts of the right shoulder onto the right needle and place the SM (BOR) after these stitches (Keep previous markers in place), knit all sts of the right shoulder, cast-on 3 sts, knit until last 35 (38 -42 -45) sts of the left shoulder, cast-on 3 sts, k35 (38 -42 -45) before the SM.

Round 1: M-SM, k1, M1L, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1, SM, k1, M1L, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1, M-SM, k1, M1L, knit all sts until 1 st from SM, M1R, k1.

Round 2: knit.

Repeat round 1 and round 2, 10 (11-12-13) times more.

Divide for body and sleeves

SECTION 1:

Set-up round: M-SM, leave 62 (62 - 62 - 62) sts onto a waste yarn for the left sleeve, cast-on 6 sts, k92 (98 - 106 - 112) for front, leave 62 (62 - 62 - 62) sts for the right shoulder, cast-on 6 sts, k92 (98 - 106 - 112) sts for back, SM. There are 196 (208 - 224 - 236) sts. Body.

Round 1: knit.

Repeat round 1 reaching 32 (34 - 36- 38) cm or the desired length.

Bind off all sts loosely.

SLEEVES:

Pick-up 3 sts from the undersleeve, work 62 sts you have left and pick-up other 3 sts from the undersleeve. Place the SM (BOR).

Knit 30 cm with magic loop technique, the switch to size 6 mm tips and knit 12 rounds.

Switch to size 7 mm tips, knit 10 cm

Bind off all sts loosely.

Work the second sleeve as given for the first one.

COLLAR :

Using size 4 mm tips and 80 cm cable, on RS, pick-up all sts around the neckline.

Round 1: knit, in V-shaped front and back neckline k3tog.

Repeat round 1, 3 times.

Knit next two rounds.

Bind off all sts loosely.

Tie off the thread.

SKIRT



Shape the waistband: using waste yarn, size 3.5 mm tips and 80 cm cable, cast-on 140 (148- 156- 164) sts

Row 1: knit.

Join in the round and place one SM at beginning and end of the round.

Knit 14 rounds.

Switch to size 4 mm points, knit 14 rounds.

Fold in half this panel (WS against WS), knit 1 st from needle and 1 st from waste yarn together.

Close the waistband almost completely and insert the elastic band.

Close the waistband.

Start working the skirt in the round as follows:

Round 1: k70(74- 78- 82), place the SM, k70 (74- 78- 82), place the SM (SM1) at beginning and end of the round.

Round 2: SM, k35 (37 - 39 - 41), place the SM (SM2), k70 (74- 78- 82), place the SM (SM3), k35 (37 - 39 - 41), (SM1).

For skirt shaping, start short-needles working.

Row 1(RS): k6, turn.

Row 2(WS): purl until 6 sts after the SM1, turn.

Row 3(RS): knit until the SM1, k12, turn

Row 4(WS): purl until 12 sts after the SM1, turn

Continuing as established, work 6 more stitches across every round until you have worked 4(4-4-4) rounds on each side.

Knit one round.

SECTION 1: switch to size 4.5 mm tips

Round 1: knit until 2 sts before the SM2, M1R, k4, M1L, knit until 2 sts before the SM3, M1R, k4, M1L.

Round 2: knit.

Round 3: knit

Round 4: knit

Repeat from round 1 to round 4, 4 times, there are 156 (164 - 172 - 180) sts

SECTION 2:

Round 1: knit until 2 sts before SM2, M1R, k4, M1L, knit until 2 sts before the SM3, M1R, k4, M1L.

Round 2 to Round 8: knit.

Repeat from round 1 to round 8, 6 (6-6-6) times, there are 180 (188 - 196 -204) sts

At the same time, at 18 cm from waistband, use the orange yarn.

Place one SM (SM4) to divide the front of skirt in half.

Right back 45 (47 - 49 - 51) sts between SM1 and SM2, first half of front 45 (47 - 49 - 51) sts between SM2 and SM4, second half of front 45 (47 - 49 - 51) sts between SM4 and SM3, left back 45 (47 - 49 - 51) sts between SM3 and SM1. At the end of the round turn and slip 1 st from left needle to right needle on RS and 1 st from left needle to right needle on WS, shaping the cross. Place the SM1 between two crossed sts, return the crossed sts onto the left needle, slip first st p-wise, M-SM, and knit the sts on the left needle.

From here, do not work in the round anymore. Continue flat, working RS rounds and WS rows.

Round 1: k133 (135 - 137 - 139), using orange yarn k2, using dark blue yarn k45 (47 - 49 - 51), turn.

From here on, sts for sizes M – L - XL) will progress by 2 sts for each subsequent size

Row 1: p44 using dark blue yarn, p4 using orange yarn, p132 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 2: k131 using dark blue yarn, k6 using orange yarn, k43 using dark blue yarn, turn.

Row 2: p42 using dark blue yarn, p8 using orange yarn, p130 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 3: k129 using dark blue yarn, k10 using orange yarn, k41 using dark blue yarn, turn.

Row 3: p40 using dark blue yarn, p12 using orange yarn, p128 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 4: k127 using dark blue yarn, k14 using orange yarn, k39 using dark blue yarn, turn.

Row 4: p38 using dark blue yarn, p16 using orange yarn, p126 using dark-blue yarn 126, turn.

Round 5: k125 using dark blue yarn, k18 using orange yarn, k37 using dark blue yarn, turn.

Row 5: p36 using dark blue yarn, p20 using orange yarn, p61 using dark-blue yarn, on RS cross the 2 stitches over SM4, return them on left needle and purl until the end of the row, turn.

From this point to the end of the skirt, continue crossing over SM4.

Round 6: k123 using dark blue yarn, k22 using orange yarn, knit until the end of the round, turn

Row 6: p34 using dark blue yarn, p24 using orange yarn, using dark-blue yarn purl until the end of the row, turn.

Round 7: using dark blue yarn knit until 2 sts from SM2, M1R, k2, M-SM2, k2, M1L, k42, cross over SM4, k30, k11 using orange yarn, M1R, k2, M-SM3, k2, M1L, k11 using dark blue yarn, knit until the end of the round, turn. There are 184 (188- 192 - 196)

Row 7: p26 using dark blue yarn, p30 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn purl until the end of the row, turn.

Round 8: k117 using dark blue yarn, k32 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 8: p24 using dark blue yarn, p34 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn purl until the end of the row, turn.

Round 9: k115 using dark blue yarn, k36 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 9: p25 using dark blue yarn, p38 using orange yarn, p119 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 10: k118 using dark blue yarn, k40 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 10: p23 using dark blue yarn, p42 using orange yarn, p117 using dark-blue yarn,

turn.

Round 11: k116 using dark blue yarn, k44 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 11: p21 using dark blue yarn, p46 using orange yarn, p115 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 12: k114 using dark blue yarn, k48 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 12: p19 using dark blue yarn, p50 using orange yarn, p113 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 13: k112 using dark blue yarn, k52 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 13: p18 using dark blue yarn, p54 using orange yarn, p111 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 14: k110 using dark blue yarn, k56 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 14: p16 using dark blue yarn, p58 using orange yarn, p109 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 15: k108 using dark blue yarn, k60 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 15: p14 using dark blue yarn, p62 using orange yarn, p107 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 16: k106 using dark blue yarn, k64 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 16: p12 using dark blue yarn, p66 using orange yarn, p105 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 17: k104 using dark blue yarn, k68 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 17: p10 using dark blue yarn, p70 using orange yarn, p103 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 18: k103 using dark blue yarn, k72 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 18: p8 using dark blue yarn, p72 using orange yarn, p102 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 19: k101 using dark blue yarn, k74 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 19: p6 using dark blue yarn, p78 using orange yarn, p100 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 20: k99 using dark blue yarn, k80 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 20: p4 using dark blue yarn, p82 using orange yarn, p98 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 21: k97 using dark blue yarn, k84 using orange yarn, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 21: p2 using dark blue yarn, p86 using orange yarn, p96 using dark-blue yarn, turn.

Round 22: insert the light-blue yarn, cross, k90 using orange yarn, insert the light-blue yarn, cross, using dark blue yarn knit until the end of the round, turn.

Row 22: cross, p1 using light-blue yarn, p88 using orange yarn, p1 using light-blue yarn, cross, p94 using dark-blue yarn, p1 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 23: cross, k2, k86 using orange yarn, k2 using light-blue yarn, cross, using dark blue yarn knit until 2 sts from the end of the round, using light-blue yarn k2, turn.

Row 23: cross, p3 using light-blue yarn, p84 using orange yarn, p3 using light-blue yarn, cross, p3, p84 using dark-blue yarn, p3 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 24: cross, k4, k82 using orange yarn, k4 using light-blue yarn, cross, k4, using dark blue yarn knit until 4 sts from the end of the round, k4 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Row 24: cross, p5 using light-blue yarn, p80 using orange yarn, p5 using light-blue yarn, cross, p5, p80 using dark-blue yarn, p5 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 25: cross, k6, k78 using orange yarn, k6 using light-blue yarn, cross, k6, using dark blue yarn knit until 6 sts from the end of the round, k6 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Row 25: cross, p7 using light-blue yarn, p76 using orange yarn, p7 using light-blue yarn, cross, p7, p76 using dark-blue yarn, p7 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 26: cross, k8, k74 using orange yarn, k8 using light-blue yarn, cross, k8, using dark blue yarn knit until 8 sts from the end of the round, k8 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Row 26: cross, p9 using light-blue yarn, p72 using orange yarn, p9 using light-blue yarn, cross, p9, p72 using dark-blue yarn, p9 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 27: cross, k10, k70 using orange yarn, k10 using light-blue yarn, cross, k10, using dark blue yarn knit until 10 sts from the end of the round, k10 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Row 27: cross, p11 using light-blue yarn, p68 using orange yarn, p11 using light-blue yarn, cross, p11, p68 using dark-blue yarn, p11 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 28: cross, k12, k66 using orange yarn, k12 using light-blue yarn, cross, k12, using dark blue yarn knit until 12 sts from the end of the round, k12 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Row 28: cross, p13 using light-blue yarn, p64 using orange yarn, p13 using light-blue yarn, cross, p13, p64 using dark-blue yarn, p13 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 29: cross, k14, k62 using orange yarn, k14 using light-blue yarn, cross, k14, using dark blue yarn knit until 14 sts from the end of the round, k14 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Row 29: cross, p15 using light-blue yarn, p60 using orange yarn, p15 using light-blue yarn, cross, p15, p60 using dark-blue yarn, p15 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 30: cross, k16, k58 using orange yarn, k16 using light-blue yarn, cross, k16, using dark blue yarn knit until 16 sts from the end of the round, k16 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Row 30: p17 cross, using light-blue yarn, p56 using orange yarn, p17 using light-blue yarn, cross, p17, p56 using dark-blue yarn, p17 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 31: cross, k18, k52 using orange yarn, k18 using light-blue yarn, cross, k18, using dark blue yarn knit until 18 sts from the end of the round, k18 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Row 31: cross, p19 using light-blue yarn, p52 using orange yarn, p19 using light-blue yarn, cross, p19, p60 using dark-blue yarn, p19 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Round 32: cross, k20, k50 using orange yarn, k20 using light-blue yarn, cross, k20, using dark blue yarn knit until 20 sts from the end of the round, k20 using light-blue yarn, turn.

Row 32: cross, p21 using light-blue yarn, p48 using orange yarn, p21 using light-blue yarn, cross, p21, p48 using dark-blue yarn, p21 using light-blue yarn, turn. Total 184 sts

Round 33: cross, k21 using light-blue yarn, p44 cross, using orange yarn, using light-blue yarn cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k44 using dark-blue yarn, using light-blue yarn cross, k21, turn.

Row 33: cross, p2l using light-blue yarn, cross, p1, p43 using orange yarn, p1 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, p1, p43 using dark-blue yarn, p1 using light-blue yarn v, cross, p2l, turn.

Round 34: cross, k2l, cross, k2, k42 using orange yarn, cross, k2 using light-blue yarn, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k2, using dark blue yarn knit until 21 sts from the end of the round, k2 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, turn.

Row 34: cross, p2l using light-blue yarn, cross, p3, p41 using orange yarn, p3 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, cross, p2l, cross, p3, p41 using dark-blue yarn, p3 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, turn.

Round 35: cross, k2l using light-blue yarn, cross, k4, k40 using orange yarn, k4 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k4, k40 using dark-blue yarn, k4 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, turn.

Row 35: cross, p2l using light-blue yarn, cross, p5, p39 using orange yarn, p5 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, cross, p2l, cross, p5, p39 using dark-blue yarn, p5 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, turn.

Round 36: cross, k2l using light-blue yarn, cross, k6, k38 using orange yarn, k6 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k6, k38 using dark-blue yarn, k6 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, turn.

Row 36: cross, p2l using light-blue yarn, cross, p7, p37 using orange yarn, p7 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, cross, p2l, cross, p7, p37 using dark-blue yarn, p7 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, turn.

Round 37: cross, k2l using light-blue yarn, cross, k8, k36 using orange yarn, k8 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k8, k36 using dark-blue yarn, k8 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, turn.

Row 37: cross, p2l using light-blue yarn, cross, p9, p35 using orange yarn, p9 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, cross, p2l, cross, p9, p35 using dark-blue yarn, p9 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, turn.

Round 38: cross, using light-blue yarn k2l, cross, k10, k34 using orange yarn, k10 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k10, k34 using dark-blue yarn, k10 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, turn.

Row 38: cross, p2l using light-blue yarn, cross, p11, p33 using orange yarn, p11 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, cross, p2l, cross, p11, p33 using dark-blue yarn, p11 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, turn.

Round 39: cross, k2l using light-blue yarn, cross, k12, k32 using orange yarn, k12 using

light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k12, k32 using dark-blue yarn, k12 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, turn.

Row 39: cross, p2l using light-blue yarn, cross, p13, p 3l using orange yarn, p13 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, cross, p2l, cross, p13, p3l using dark-blue yarn, p13 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, turn.

Round 40: cross, k2l using light-blue yarn, cross, k14, k30 using orange yarn, k14 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k14, k30 using dark-blue yarn, k14 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, turn.

Row 40: cross, p2l using light-blue yarn, cross, p15, p29 using orange yarn, p15 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, cross, p2l, cross, p15, p29 using dark-blue yarn, p15 using light-blue yarn, cross, p2l, turn.

Continue from Round/Row 41 to Round/Row 55, following the pattern. Orange and blue sts decrease progressively to 0 on round 55, while the side light blue sections increase by the same amount, maintaining a total of 184 sts

Switch to size 6 mm tips and work from Round/Row 55, 11 times.

LAST SECTION:

Insert orange yarn

Round 1: cross using orange yarn, k2l using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross using orange yarn, k2l using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, turn. Total 184 sts

Row 1: cross using orange yarn, p1, p20 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k20, p1 using orange yarn, cross, p1, k20 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k20, p1 using orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Round 2: cross using orange yarn, p2, p19 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k19, p2 using orange yarn, cross, p2, k19 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k19, p2 using orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Row 2: cross using orange yarn, p3, p18 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k18, p3, cross, p3 using orange yarn, k18 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k18, p3 using orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Round 3: cross using orange yarn, p4, p17 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k17, p4 using orange yarn, cross, p4, k17 using light-blue yarn, cross, k2l, cross, k2l, cross, k17, p4 using orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Row 3: k, p5, p16 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k16, p5 with orange yarn, cross, p5, k16 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k16, p5 with orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Round 4: cross using orange yarn, p6, p15 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k15, p6 using orange yarn, cross, p6, k15 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k15, c p6 using orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Row 4: cross using orange yarn, p7, p14 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k14, p7 using orange yarn, cross, p7, k14 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k14, p7 using orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Switch to size 7 mm tips.

Round 5: cross using orange yarn, p8, p13 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k13, p8 using orange yarn, cross, p8, k13 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k13, p8 using orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Row 5: cross using orange yarn, p9, p12 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k12, p9 using orange yarn, cross, p9, k12 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k12, p9 using orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Round 6: cross using orange yarn, p10, p11 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k11, p10 using orange yarn, cross, p10, k11 using light-blue yarn, cross, k21, cross, k21, cross, k11, p10 using orange yarn, turn. There are 184 sts

Repeat sequence and progression in the same way until

Round 11 / Row 11 = 20 sts with orange and 1 st with light blue;

Round 12 / Row 12 = 21 sts with orange and 0 sts with light blue.

Using the orange yarn work I-Cord in the round as follows: work 3 new sts into the first st of the left needle, * k3, ssk, move 4 sts from right needle to left needle, * repeat from * to * until the end of the round.

Tie off the threads.

SWEATER INSTRUCTIONS

The garment is worked in the round and seamlessly using the Top-Down technique. The armholes are worked in the round using the magic loop technique. The instructions below are for size S; for other sizes, follow the instructions in parentheses (M-L-XL).

SKIRT INSTRUCTIONS

The first piece of the garment is worked seamlessly in the round with a slight A-line shape. The second piece is worked flat in back-and-forth rows closing every row, always seamlessly. The instructions below are for size S; for other sizes, follow the instructions in parentheses (M-L-XL).
