

# GREEK MEN

## DIFFICULTY =

**Needed:** Laines du Nord [Aran Tweed](#) yarn 8 balls of g. 50, needles n 5.5 / 6 with 8- 1 elbow with 9  
60, 100 cm cable, 4 point markers (MP) of which 1 in a different color



This men's shirt is knitted in the Top Down round, from top to bottom. The construction of the spur is round, so it has increases distributed over the entire width.

## SAMPLE

10x10 cm = 15 stitches, 20 rounds in stockinette stitch

## POINTS USED

Stockinette stitch, past stitch pattern

## ABBREVIATIONS

m = stitch (e);

MP = point mark;

pMP = pass MP

LD = right side of the work

LR = wrong side of the piece

dr = straight;

r = reverse;

viv = edge;

2ins = 2 sts together knit

3ins = 3 sts together knit

acc = simple overlap: slip a stitch without knitting it, 1 dr, overlap the passed stitch over that worked.

get = one toss

rip \*\* =

repeat from \* to \*

## MEASURES

The measure starts from TG 46, developed in TG 48/50

**MEASURES TG 46 neckline cc 55 cm; total length 63 cm; BUST width about 110 cm; sleeve length from neck 67 cm; armhole from the neck 28 cm, cuff 26 cm**

## PROCEDURE

START with the needles n.5,5 cast on 80 (84/88) stitches, 1 to close in the round, put MP of a different color, which is that of START OF ROUND

EDGE and setting

For 6 rounds work rib K 2, P 2 to the end of the ROUND

PRECISATION: now everything is worked in stockinette stitch, to facilitate the execution of the increases. When the sleeves are divided, the work is turned up to make the stocking purl to the right side.

CHANGE the tip and put the no. 6

1 R = \* size 46 10 k, size 48 11 k size 50 12 k, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 8 times if stitches remain, finish the round knit.

Total = size 46 mesh 88, size 48 mesh 92, size 50 mesh 96.

Round 2 to 6 = straight

7 R = \* K 5, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 17 times (18/19 times) finish the round straight.

Total = Size 46 links. 105, size 48 mesh 110, size 50 mesh 115.

Round 8 to 13 = completely straight

14 R = \* K 6, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 17 times (18/19 times) finish the round straight.

Total = Size 46 links. 122, size 48 mesh 128, size 50 mesh 134.

Round 15 to round 20 = completely straight

21 R = \* 7 K, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 17 times (18/19 times) finish the round straight.

Total = Size 46 links. 139, size 48 mesh 146, size 50 mesh 153.

Round 22 to round 27 = completely straight

28 R = \* 8 k, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 17 times (18/19 times) finish the round straight.

Total = Size 46 links. 156, size 48 mesh 169, size 50 mesh 172.

Round 29 to round 34 = completely straight

35 R = \* K 9, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 17 times (18/19 times) finish the round straight.

Total = size 46 mesh 173, size 48 mesh 182, size 50 mesh 191.

Round 36 to round 41 = completely straight

From here on, follow the instructions for your TG.

ONLY X TG 46 = 42 G = \* 9 k, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 19 times, finish the round straight.

Total = 192 stitches,

Round 43 to 47 = straight

48 R = \* 8 k, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 22 times, finish round knit.

Total = 214 stitches

From round 49 to round 50 = straight = FROM HERE TO THE SLEEVE DIVISION



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ONLY X TG 48 = 42 G = \* 7 k, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 25 times, finish the round straight.

Total = 207 links,

Round 43 to 47 = straight

48 R = \* 8 k, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 25 times, finish round knit.

Total = 232 links,

From round 49 to round 52 = straight = FROM HERE TO THE SLEEVE DIVISION

ONLY X TG 50 = 42 G = \* 6 k, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 30 times, finish straight round.

Total = 221 stitches

Round 43 to 47 = straight

48 R = \* 7 k, 1 Aum inv \* repeat from \* to \* x 31 times, finish the round knit.

Total = 252 stitches.

From round 49 to round 54 = straight = FROM HERE TO THE SLEEVE DIVISION

PREPARATION TO SUSPEND THE SLEEVE SHIRTS FOR ALL SIZES

RIB TRANSITION ROUND 2/2 TO BE DOUBLED IN CASE OF ODD LINKS: IF IT ENDS WITH 1 dir, pmp, restart with 1 dir.

Departure from initial MP:

BEHIND 65 (70/76) rib stitches K 2, P 2, put MP,

SLEEVE 42 (46/50) rib stitches 2 K, 2 P, put MP

FRONT 65 (70/76) rib stitches 2 K, 2 P, put MP,

SLEEVE 42 (46/50) rib stitches K 2, P 2, = END OF ROUND

TURN PIECE so that the reverse stockinette stitch is on the right side.

Departure from initial MP (DO NOT REMOVE):

SLEEVE straight up to MP, SUSPEND, on a waste thread, the stitches just worked TOGLIERE MP,

FRONT straight up to Mp, Pmp,

SLEEVE straight up to MP, SUSPEND the stitches just worked on a waste thread.

BEHIND straight up to Mp at the end of the LAP

JOIN THE WORK IN THE ROUND:

ASSEMBLE 5 (7/9) stitches again, join the back with the front by simply approaching the piece and work by pulling the yarn well. Work ALL stitches straight,

ASSEMBLE 5 (7/9) stitches again, join the FRONT with the BACK simply approaching the work and work pulling the yarn well, working straight until the end of the ROUND.

NOW CONTINUE TO WORK IN THE ROUND SHINED KNIT FOR CM 26/30

GRECA PATTERN WITH PASSED LINKS multiple of 4 stitches:

THIS EXPLANATION CAN BE USED BOTH FOR THE FINAL PART OF THE BUST AND FOR THE SLEEVE.

WITH THE CONTRASTING COLOR:

R 1 = \* K 2, pull 2 stitches with back loop (do not PULL THREAD) \* repeat for all stitches

WITH THE base COLOR

2 R = \* pull 2 stitches with back loop (do not PULL THREAD), K 2, \* repeat for all stitches

WITH THE CONTRASTING COLOR:

3 G = same as 1

WITH THE base COLOR

4 G = same as 2

WITH THE CONTRASTING COLOR:

5/6/7/8/9 g = all straight

EDGE WITH THE BASIC COLOR

10 g = all straight

11/12/13/14/15/16 R = knit rib 2 K, 2 P, for 6/8 rounds,

(measure the LENGTH of both the bust and the sleeve if you still need to make a few more turns of the 2/2 ribbed edge)

THEN 1 purl round then close

#### RECOMMENDED CLOSURE

\* 2 stitches knit together taken from the back, move the stitch from the right needle back to the left one \* now repeat from \* to \* until the end of the stitches.

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#### SLEEVES: general indications: GET BACK THE SLEEVE SHIRTS

PUT the stitches you have put on hold on a small circular needle (short tips and 40 cm cable), then with a new thread also collect the increased stitches of the undersleeve, they are the same as previously mounted 2 per side. HIGHLIGHT 2 MP.

Continue in stockinette stitch in the round, then straight across, making the decreases OUTSIDE the stitch markers AS THIS WAY:

before MP make 1 overlapping stitch, after Mp make 2 stitches together knit, every 5/6 cm. until you have 36 (max 40 stitches) left to be able to make the PASS stitch pattern. THEN work in stockinette stitch for 42/44 cm.

THEN MOVE TO GREEK AND EDGE WITH THE ABOVE EXPLANATIONS.
