

WARM AUTUMN

DIFFICULTY =

YARN

[Soft Lino](#) by Laines du Nord (80% Flax, 20% Pima Cotton):

4 (5, 6,7) balls x 50 grams / 135 metres

TOOLS

Size 4 mm knitting needles (100 cm of cables and 40 cm for the sleeves)

16 markers (8 of one colour and 8 of another so as not to confuse them)



This crop cardigan is worked, from the top-down, back and forth on circular needles to make room for all stitches. Sleeves are worked in the round seamless.
Medium difficulty.

SAMPLE

21 stitches and 28 rows = 10x10 cm in stocking stitch using size 4 mm knitting needles

POINTS USED

ABBREVIATIONS

m = stitch (e);

MP = point mark;

pMP = pass MP

LD = right side of the work

LR = wrong side of the piece

dr = straight;

r = reverse;

viv = edge;

2ins = 2 sts together knit

3ins = 3 sts together knit

acc = simple overlap: slip a stitch without knitting it, 1 dr, overlap the passed stitch over that worked.

get = one toss

rip ** = repeat from * to *

MEASURES

S (M, L, XL). See last photo for the measures of the finished garment. This crop cardigan is designed to fit with no ease or with few cm of negative ease at the bust. The cardigan remains open on the front.

Sample in photos is a size M worn with 6 cm of negative ease.
